This homework is OPTIONAL.

It is an opportunity for you to produce something special.

Choose projects to complete and return them to school before 9th February. The 'hotter' the dish, the greater the number of house points.

Mild will be a minimum of 8 house points.

Medium will be a minimum of 12 house points.

Hot will be a minimum of 16 house points.



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| Hot | <u>Model</u> Make a junk model of a lighthouse OR an island with features such as cliffs and beaches. | <u>Calendar</u> Create a calendar for the months of the year. Write / draw key events for as many months as you can. When is Bonfire Night, Halloween, New Year's Day.... |
| Medium | <u>Create</u> Create a chart of healthy food with words and pictures | <u>Story</u> Write a story set on an island...maybe it's a treasure island! |
| Mild | <u>Map</u> Make a map of your journey to school. Use pictures and labels to show places that you pass. | <u>Maths</u> Make a clock face with moveable hands to help you tell the time. |
